

**LNCS/LNAI/LNBI –
Terms for Bulk Purchases of
Conference Proceedings**



Springer LNCS offers its conference and workshop proceedings as

- printed books;
- printed books with CD-ROM included;
- CD-ROMs (delivered in jewel cases or slim boxes);
- USB sticks

By default, LNCS volumes are produced as printed books only. CD-ROMs or USBs (containing the electronic content of the respective printed proceedings) are only produced for conferences/symposia/workshops, if organizers or volume editors have explicitly requested this.

CD-ROMs and USBs of LNCS volumes are not kept in stock and are not available for individual purchase from the warehouse.

Our CD-ROM and USB proceedings include pdf full-text search functionality, author index and bibtex files. The minimum number of CDs or USBs that have to be purchased is 50.

We offer CDs either accompanying print copies (attached to the inner back cover of the books) or as separate items (in slim/jewel cases).

► If you require any **CDs or USBs**, kindly make sure that we are informed when you upload the electronic manuscript to our server.

1. Prices for Bulk Purchases of Conference Proceedings

1.1. Prices for Books or Books incl. CD-ROMs

Volume editors or conference organizers may buy copies of their proceedings from us at preferential rates (which correspond to a discount of at least 50% off the list price). Prices vary according to the number of pages in a volume and the number of copies purchased. Please see the table below for details.

All prices shown in this document are net Euro prices.

The page ranges referred to are total page counts incl. all front- and back-matter pages.

If you are interested in having a CD-ROM inserted in the conference copies of your book, then please note that this option is only available if at least 50 copies are purchased.

► Please note that as of 2010, we can accommodate no more than a **maximum of 800 pages** (incl. front- and backmatter) in one LNCS/LNAI/LNBI volume.

1.2. Prices for Multiple-Volume Book Sets

If the total number of pages in a proceedings exceeds 800 pages, then the content has to be split across two or more print volumes by the volume editors. Respecting natural break points, we aim to distribute pages equally among the volumes of a set.

The prices for print proceedings published in more than one LNCS volume are calculated by adding the individual bulk prices for the volumes needed. There are, however, additional discounts applied to the prices of the print proceedings sets:

# Volumes in Set	Discount on Bulk Prices	Discount Factor
2	20%	0,80
3	30%	0,70
4	35%	0,65
5	40%	0,60

If a multiple-volume book set is to be accompanied by a CD-ROM, then one disk containing the content of all proceedings volumes will be attached to the inner back cover of the first volume of the set.

The prices for book sets including CD-ROMs are calculated as follows:

$$\text{number of sets} \times \left[\text{number of books per set} \times \left(\text{net unit price} + \text{price of CD} \right) \right] \times \text{discount factor for number of volumes in set}$$

- Example: 2100 pages, 150 book sets incl. CD-ROM to be ordered
 3 volumes à 700 pages needed
 50 book sets (incl. CD) for free (please see Sect. 2. regarding free copies)
 Costs for 100 three-volume sets incl. CD-ROM:
 $100 \times [3 \times (\text{EUR } 38 + \text{EUR } 5)] \times 0,7 = \text{EUR } 9.030$

1.3 Prices for CD-ROMs or USBs

We can also provide, for distribution at conferences and workshops, CD-ROM or USB proceedings delivered as separate items.

The prices of CD-ROMs delivered in slim cases or of USBs depend on the total number of text pages needed in the printed books as follows:

CD-ROMs and USBs are only offered if at least 50 copies are purchased.

Please note that there are no discounts applied to CD-ROM and USB prices.

2. Free Copies

No royalties are paid for editing LNCS volumes, however, **50 complimentary copies** are given to the volume editors. By default, these free copies are given as printed books, even in the case where no additional copies are purchased.

If at least 100 CDs or USBs are purchased, then the volume editors may chose whether they wish to get the 50 free copies as books or as CDs/USBs.

CDs are included in the 50 complimentary print copies if at least 100 print copies with CDs are purchased.

3. Free Online Conference Service

Springer now offers the Online Conference Service OCS to help PC chairs manage the submission and review process. All conferences whose proceedings have been accepted for publication in the LNCS series may now use OCS - with technical support - free of charge.

4. Shipping Costs

Please note that, besides the costs for the books, CDs or USBs, the transportation costs also have to be covered for both the purchased and the free copies.

If you need a shipping quote, then please send an email to lncs@springer.com, giving the delivery address as well as the number of pages (roughly) your proceedings will have and the number of copies you will require.

5. Various

Please note that all prices are subject to (local) VAT. If the billing party has a VAT number, then this should be sent to the Editorial Assistant in charge of the project, when the final order is made. If the billing party provides a VAT number, then no VAT will be invoiced by Springer.

If you anticipate that a proforma invoice or any other special paperwork will be necessary for the dispatch of the books, then please let us know well in advance.
